There will be no premiums or prize monies awarded except in Youth Showmanship. Rosettes will be awarded for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion in each division and Champion Challenge/Best in Breed.

The order of the show IS subject to change at the discretion of the show committee.

Animals without papers may not be shown. Junior and Senior Bucks will be sanctioned together. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned.

The following breeds are sanctioned by American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA) and will be shown as listed: Nigerian Dwarf. The Junior and Senior Does shows are separately sanctioned. ADGA Rules shall govern.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE 2020 March Mini Madness Show

ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted up to and including the day of the show. Entry fee is \$15 per animal for NDGCF members, \$20 per animal for nonmembers for entries received (postmarked or emailed by Saturday, February 29th, 2020. Entries received after February 29th or on the day of the show will be \$20 per entry for NDGCF Members and \$25 per entry for non-members. (Remember on entry is for all 3 rings.)

Substitutions will be accepted upon arrival. All substitutions will be done at check in time from 7:30 am – 8:30 am.

Exhibitor may provide own pens or 4' x 6' hog stalls in the barn can be rented for \$5 for March 6th-8th only. If you want shavings, you need to supply your own. No straw or hay for bedding. You must clean up any hay or trash after use. You have the option to pay \$5 per pen to have it cleaned for you. See entry form. If you set up your own pens, you must clean up your area before release from show.

The official registration certificate is required for all animals 6 mos. of age or older. A duplicate application for registration stamped by the ADGA office is permissible for animals under 6 months of age.

The registration or stamped duplicate application must be available to the show secretary at the time of arrival.

All animals must be naturally polled, dehorned or dis-budded.

A concession stand will be available for breakfast and lunch with a large variety to choose from, reasonably priced.

SHOWMANSHIP: Judging will be based on the ADGA Showmanship Scorecard. Premiums will be awarded. Rosettes and ribbons will be awarded. Winner's certificates available thru ADGA. See www.adga.org for more information on the Showmanship requirements. All youth exhibitors will be required to be clean and neat and dressed in white or black jeans or slacks with a solid white shirt with a white collar. Youth may wear 4H or FFA attire. No caps or hats. Closed-toed shoes or boots are required. Exhibitors not conforming to the Dress Code will not be allowed to enter the Show Ring. Showmanship entries are free. Exhibitors must show a dairy goat officially entered in the open show. Showmanship entry must be filled out and given at check in (separate from open entry).

OPEN SHOW ATTIRE

- Dress is casual. Closed toed shoes or boots are required.
- Exhibitors not conforming to dress code will not be allowed to enter the ring.

RELEASE

- Animals are released upon completion of their classes.
- CLEAN UP of your area required before departure.
- Option to pay for CLEAN UP is \$5 per pen, you pay when you enter or at check in

- Areas will be checked before release
